Family Wellbeing:-

Based on the above data of accumulative average of families' participation, the 1st. Checkpoint of Family Outcome report shows that <u>69</u> families participated in the assessment. <u>70%</u> of families obtained the highest score of <u>3</u> - <u>strength</u>, <u>29%</u> families obtained <u>2</u> –<u>making progress</u>, and <u>1%</u> families obtained <u>1</u> - <u>need assistance</u>.

Positive Parent Child Behavior:-

Based on the above data of accumulative average of families' participation, the 1st. Checkpoint of Family Outcome report shows that <u>69</u> families participated in the assessment. <u>81%</u> families obtained the highest score of <u>3</u> - <u>strength</u>, <u>18%</u> families obtained <u>2</u> –<u>making progress</u>, and <u>1%</u> families obtained <u>1</u> - <u>need assistance</u>.

Families as Lifelong Educators:-

Based on the above data of accumulative average of families' participation, the 1st. Checkpoint of Family Outcome report shows that <u>69</u> families participated in the assessment. <u>77%</u> families obtained the highest score of <u>3</u> - <u>strength</u>, <u>16%</u> families obtained <u>2</u> –<u>making progress</u>, and <u>7%</u> families obtained <u>1</u> - <u>need assistance</u>.

Family as Learners:-

Based on the above data of accumulative average of families' participation, the 1st. Checkpoint of Family Outcome report shows that <u>69</u> families participated in the assessment. <u>71%</u> families obtained the highest score of <u>3</u> - <u>strength</u>, <u>28%</u> families obtained <u>2</u> –<u>making progress</u>, and <u>1%</u> families obtained <u>1</u> - <u>need assistance</u>.

Family Engagement in Transitions:-

Based on the above data of accumulative average of families' participation, the 1st. Checkpoint of Family Outcome report shows that <u>69</u> families participated in the assessment. <u>66%</u> families obtained the highest score of <u>3</u> - <u>strength</u>, <u>29%</u> families obtained <u>2</u> –<u>making progress</u>, and <u>5%</u> families obtained <u>1</u> - <u>need assistance</u>.

Family Connections to Peers and Community:-

Based on the above data of accumulative average of families' participation, the 1st. Checkpoint of Family Outcome report shows that <u>69</u> families participated in the assessment. <u>54%</u> families obtained the highest score of <u>3</u> - <u>strength</u>, <u>40%</u> families obtained <u>2</u> –<u>making progress</u>, and <u>6%</u> families obtained <u>1</u> - <u>need assistance</u>.

Families as Advocates and Leaders:-

Based on the above data of accumulative average of families' participation, the 1st. Checkpoint of Family Outcome report shows that <u>69</u> families participated in the assessment. <u>62%</u> families obtained the highest score of <u>3</u> - <u>strength</u>, <u>27%</u> families obtained <u>2</u> –<u>making progress</u>, and <u>11%</u> families obtained <u>1</u> - <u>need assistance</u>.
